What is Secret Pal Program?

• It is a program that anonymously matches individuals from across our College so they can spread good wishes and help make others feel appreciated.


We all need some special attention from time to time.
 Secret Pals make you feel good because that's their job!


How does it work?

- As a participant, you fill out a questionnaire about yourself. These are collected and placed "in a pot". Each participant then choses a questionnaire out of the pot making sure that no one has picked their own name. This person becomes your Pal.
- You are the Secret Pal to the person whose name you've picked. Over the course of the Secret Pal experience (we recommend at least three months), your "mission" is to do creative, spontaneous, fun and enlivening things for your partner...all anonymously, of course.
- Your Pal -> someone receiving gifts from you
- Your Secret Pal → someone sending you gifts

Interpersonal Communication Theory

- Developed by Irwin Altman and Dallas Taylor, the social penetration theory was made to provide conceptual framework that describes the development in interpersonal relationships. This theory refers to the reciprocity of behaviors between two people who are in the process of developing a relationship.
- This theory is best known as the "onion theory". This analogy suggests that like an onion, personalities have "layers" that start from the outside (what the public sees) all the way to the core (one's private self). Often, when a relationship begins to develop, it is customary for the individuals within the relationship to undergo a process of self-disclosure. As people divulge information about themselves, their "layers" begin to peel, and once those "layers" peel away they cannot go back; just like you can't put the layers back on an onion.

Interpersonal Communication Theory

There are four different stages that social penetration theory encompasses.

- ✓ Orientation stage At first, strangers exchange very little amounts of information and they are very cautious in their interactions.
- ✓ Exploratory affective stage Next, individuals become somewhat more friendly and relaxed with their communication styles.
- ✓ Affective exchange In the third stage, there is a high amount of open communication between individuals.
- ✓ **Stable stage** The final stage, simply consists of continued expressions of open and personal types of interaction.

Interpersonal Communication Theory

Secret Pal program is appropriate for EVERY level of the social interaction — it is up to the participant how much she or he wants to reveal to the other person.

BUT

It is very well suited to facilitate the growth of these interactions, the move from one level to the next.

All this psychobabble simply means that...

It is good to know even better the people we work with!

AND

...Secret Pal programs are a great and fun way to get to know your co-workers.

 - ☐ Make some time to introduce & promote the Secret Pal program
 - ☐ Give deadlines to collect questionnaires
 - ☐ At SRJC we typically have 14 weeks program
 - ☐ Make the REVEAL at your end of semester events












Reminders, reminders, reminders...


- Emails (create a DL for your program and send all the emails BCC)







Please also think about the Secret Pal program overall. I will email you a short survey soon, just to check what worked well, what did not work, what are your expectations and wishes for the next semester.



We have great departments/clubs fundraisers on the campus – try to look there first for your gift ideas: this way you

make a double gift.

Support your local business or non-profits, talented family members or students when purchasing little gifts.

But remember:

It is really a thought that counts not the money that you spend in this program.

How much does happiness cost? Not much!

If you want to be happy, you're better off spending \$5 on a friend than you are \$20 on yourself.

In a series of simple experiments, Elizabeth Dunn and colleagues (2008) assigned participants to one of four conditions, giving them envelopes of cash and instructions on how to spend it. Each envelope contained either \$5 or \$20 and told participants to spend the cash on themselves or on someone else. At the end of the day, the researchers contacted the participants to see whose happiness was most affected by their purchase.
