Southeast

- Match work to committees-make it topical
- *Tri-chair format*
- Each committee has mandated classified representation/sense of balance
- 2-year terms on committees
- *Committee reports*
- Invite friends/competition
- Emerging leaders conference
- Establish strong relationship with faculty

Southwest

- Communicate to night/swing shifts – include everyone! Let them know about release time re: participation
