College Futures Foundation Funds Leadership Training Programs To Sustain 'Caring Campus' Initiatives

The California-based <u>College Futures Foundation</u> has approved a \$367,000 grant to the Institute for Evidence-Based Change (IEBC) to support management transition of Caring Campus California to the California Community College Classified Senate (4CS) and implement training programs for California community college professional classified staff to lead and institutionalize Caring Campus initiatives at their campuses, improving their student success outcomes.

Key outcomes from this grant are to include:

- 1: Institutionalize and sustain Caring Campus at California's community colleges.
- 2: Support the development of a management infrastructure to support Caring Campus California transitioning to the California Community Colleges Classified Senate (4CS).
- 3: Implement a professional development program designed to foster and support leadership roles among the classified professionals at California's community colleges.

"Classified professionals are often the first point of contact for students, and as such, make an impact on student engagement. Caring Campus provides a path to strengthen the student experience. Classified professionals and faculty implement behavioral commitments intentionally and campus-wide that have been demonstrated to support this objective.
